
Tips, games, and activities for your child's birthday party

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
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8 steps to a successful party

It's that time of year again: Your child's birthday is coming up and you want to throw a special party – but where to begin? These eight steps will help you plan the celebration from start to finish.



6 PLAN ACTIVITIES AND GAMES	For kids, a birthday party is all about having fun – eating cake, playing games, showing off costumes, and making memories. From treasure hunts and sack races to face painting and dance-offs, we've rounded up a treasure trove of games and activities ideas to match any season or theme.
SORT OUT THE FOOD	Dinosaur biscuits, farm-fresh nibbles, or magical drinks – what fits your theme? Snack ideas include mini sandwiches, veggie sticks with dips, fruit skewers, and popcorn. Or for something more filling, pizza, hot dogs, and pasta salad are always a crowd-pleaser. And don't forget a showstopper birthday cake , complete with candles to blow out. And what about drinks ? Homemade juices or lemonades make the perfect thirst-quenchers.
8 PREPARE THE GOODIE BAGS	"Remember Sarah's party with the magician? It was epic!" If you want your party guests to rave about the event for a long time to

If you want your party guests to rave about the event for a long time to come, we recommend handing out goodie bags at the end of the party. Fill them with treats like sweets, small toys, crayons, stickers, or bubbles, all presented in a theme-appropriate package.

SAMPLE PARTY SCHEDULE

2:00-2:15 p.m.	Guests arrive and settle in
2:15-2:45 p.m.	Free play or crafting time
2:45-3:15 p.m.	First group game, like a treasure hunt
3:15-3:30 p.m.	Snack and drink break
3:30-4:00 p.m.	Second group game, such as musical chairs
4:00-4:15 p.m.	Present opening and cake
4:15-4:45 p.m.	Free play or sports activities
4:45-5:00 p.m.	Farewells and handing out goodie bags

5 tips for unwrapping presents

The highlight of any birthday bash? The present unwrapping! Colourful paper, parcels of all shapes and sizes, and shiny ribbons test the kids' patience. When it's finally time to open them, games can make the experience even more thrilling – not just for the birthday star but for their guests, too. Here are a few ideas.

GIFT CIRCLE

Have all the children sit in a circle. Play some music and pass the presents around. When the music stops, the birthday child gets to open the gift they're holding.

Variation: The birthday child stands blindfolded in the middle of the circle and spins. When the music stops, they point to a child, who then hands over their gift to be opened.

ΗΟΤ ΡΟΤΑΤΟ

The children sit in a circle, passing a gift around as the music plays. When the music stops, the child holding the present opens it – but it's always for the birthday child, of course! Variation: Instead of passing a gift, use a small object. When the music stops, the child holding the object selects a gift to give to the birthday child.



SPIN THE SPOON

The children sit in a circle with a wooden spoon placed in the middle. One child spins the spoon. When it stops, the child it points to selects a gift for the birthday child to open.

Variation: The child the spoon points to decides how the birthday child should open the present – maybe with their eyes closed or using just one hand!

LUCKY NUMBERS

Gather the children in a circle and take turns rolling a die. If a child rolls a six, they get to pick a gift to hand to the birthday child to unwrap. Keep rolling until all the presents are opened.

Variation: Make it more exciting by assigning actions to different numbers. For example: Roll a 1: Sing "Happy Birthday" before picking a gift. Roll a 3: The birthday child must open the gift with their eyes closed. Roll a 5: Everyone claps for the person who handed over the gift!

TREASURE CHEST

Place all the gifts in a large, decorated treasure chest. The birthday child pulls out each gift one at a time to open.

Variation: Write clues or descriptions for each gift and place them in a hat. Each child picks a slip of paper to help the birthday child choose the next "treasure" to unwrap.




EMOJI GUESSING GAME

CHOCOLATE FEAST


You need:


- A chocolate bar

- A die
- A table and chairs


Svolgimento:


- 1. Place the chocolate and utensils on the table, along with the clothing.
- **2.** Sit in a circle around the table.
- **3.** Take turns rolling the die. If you roll a 6, quickly put on the hat, scarf, and gloves, then use the knife and fork to cut and eat the chocolate.
- 4. Meanwhile, the others continue rolling. As soon as the next child rolls a 6, the previous child must quickly stop passing the clothes to the next child, who now also tries to open the chocolate or eat as much of it as possible before the next 6 is rolled.

The game ends when the chocolate is gone, or you can set a timer and declare the winner as the one who's eaten the most.
